# UM Swimming Pool Challenge Fun 2023 (For UM International Students) Activity Information

Date: 27 September 2023 (Wed)

Time: 15:00 - 17:00

Venue: Sports Complex - Swimming Pool (N8)

1. **Event Introduction:** The event is conducted in the form of recreational sports competition, and participating teams are required to consist of mixed-gender members. All participating teams will compete against each other through a series of games on the day of the event. The game rules will be announced by the organizers.

#### 2. Competition Format:

2.1 Participating teams are required to complete 4 games according to the rules, and the rankings will be determined by timing or scoring for each game. Each team will earn certain points based on their ranking in each game, as shown in the table below:

2.2 Calculation of results: After all teams have completed all game events, the top 3 teams with the highest cumulative scores will be awarded the first, second, and third places, respectively.

## 3. Registration Details:

- 3.1 Registration Period: From now until 15 Sep (Friday) 23:59.

- 3.3 Each team can have a maximum of 5 participants, including at least 2 male and 2 female participants.
- 3.4 Each participant must sign a declaration stating that they are able to swim continuously for at least 50 meters, confirming their health condition is suitable for participating in the event, and agreeing to take full responsibility for any health changes that may occur during the event.

- 3.5 After submitting the registration form, a participating team must submit the modification request email to candiceleong@um.edu.mo before 23:59 on the day of the technical meeting if there is any revision on team name. Changes will not be accepted after the deadline.
- 3.6 If there is a need to change the list or information of team members, it must be requested 30 minutes before the official start of the event and the above mentioned declaration (point 3.4) must be signed. Changes will not be accepted after the deadline.
- 3.7 Once registered, it indicates agreement and compliance with all provisions of this charter.

## 5. Important Notes:

- 5.1 For safety and hygiene purposes, participants must wear swimwear (swimsuit/trunks). Wearing non-standard swimwear is strictly prohibited and will not be allowed to participate. Participants may also wear team clothing (limited to T-shirt uniforms that do not discolor when wet);
  - \*Friendly reminder: When choosing swimwear, consider the main factor of avoiding wardrobe malfunctions.
- 5.2 Participating teams can choose their own team name and group outfit, but any messages related to public opinion or use offensive language or sensitive terms are not allowed.
- 5.3 Participants must bring their own equipment, including swim caps, goggles, swim trunks/swimsuits, a large towel (for warmth), and non-slip slippers.

#### 6. Remarks:

- 6.1 The activity will be postponed or cancelled when rainstorm black warning, a typhoon signal number 8 or above on the day of the event. Subject to the announcement of the organizer.
- 6.2 The organizer reserves the right to amend the terms and conditions. In case of any disputes, the organizer has the final decision making power.
