2024 OUTCOMES

- 1 34 students from 21 schools in 5 countries
- 2 71% young women, 29% young men
- 3 88% anticipate using what they learned in the programme
- 4 91% felt that they developed a clear SDGs project plan
- 5 96% responded that their understanding of key SDG principles improved
- 6 84% reported being highly satisfied with the course content

-  Empower participants to launch their SDG projects

Programme Structure

Launched in 2021, the UNITAR Youth Ambassador Asia Pacific Programme aims to empower high school students across the region, developing their ability to address international issues and the SDGs.

Participants in the 8-week programme attend webinars and lectures from experts in all sectors. They develop ideas to combat community problems, receiving mentoring and coaching from UNITAR and ITS staff. At the end, all participants present self-directed capstone projects, including non-profit organisations and start-ups. Participants will then receive a certificate of completion signed by UNITAR.
