- ✓ Cumulative GPA greater than 2.0
- ✓ GBM students
 - Mandatory to join semester exchange programme
- ✓ FBA Master students
 - Take note of several partner schools accepting PG students
 - Credit transfer is not eligible for PG students

Points to note

➤ Cross check of study plan for credit transfer

- Check your study plan
- Risks of credit transfer
- Not a reason for withdrawal

➤ Tuition fees

- Students shall pay tuition fees to UM while the tuition fees at partner school will be waived

➤ Other expenses

- Students are responsible for their own financial support for the exchange, including but not limited to accommodation, transportation, insurance and visa, etc

➤ Notify your parents about your exchange

- As you may have limited time to make your decision, it is important to have a conversation with them in advance to discuss the details and gather their input

➤ Read through the “Rules for Semester-based Outgoing Exchange Programmes”





How can you Apply?

✓ Application System

- *Applications should be made via the “Outbound Exchange and Scholarship Application System” (website: <https://isw.um.edu.mo/seas>);*

✓ Period: 15 – 23 January 2026

✓ Follow the instructions in website and fill out all required documents, upload into the system.

✓ Make sure you read through the credit transfer requirement

✓ Submit Learning Agreement (Part 3 of FBA website) BEFORE exchange and Course Exemption Application (Part 4 of FBA website) AFTER exchange
