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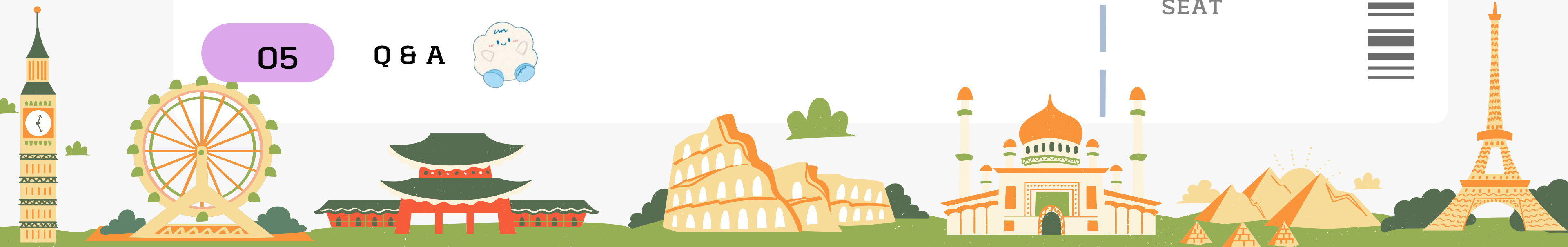

# Types of Programmes

Students should read the '**Rules for Semester-based Outgoing Exchange Programmes**' and pay attention to the insurance and minimum enrollment requirements (UG students must enrol at least **9 UM equivalent credits** (i.e. **at least 108 teaching hours** in total) at the host university per semester).

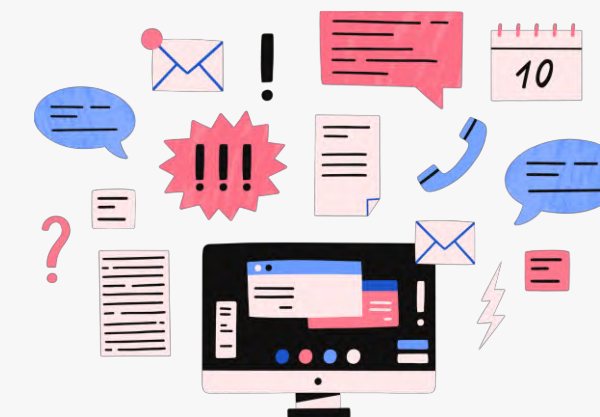

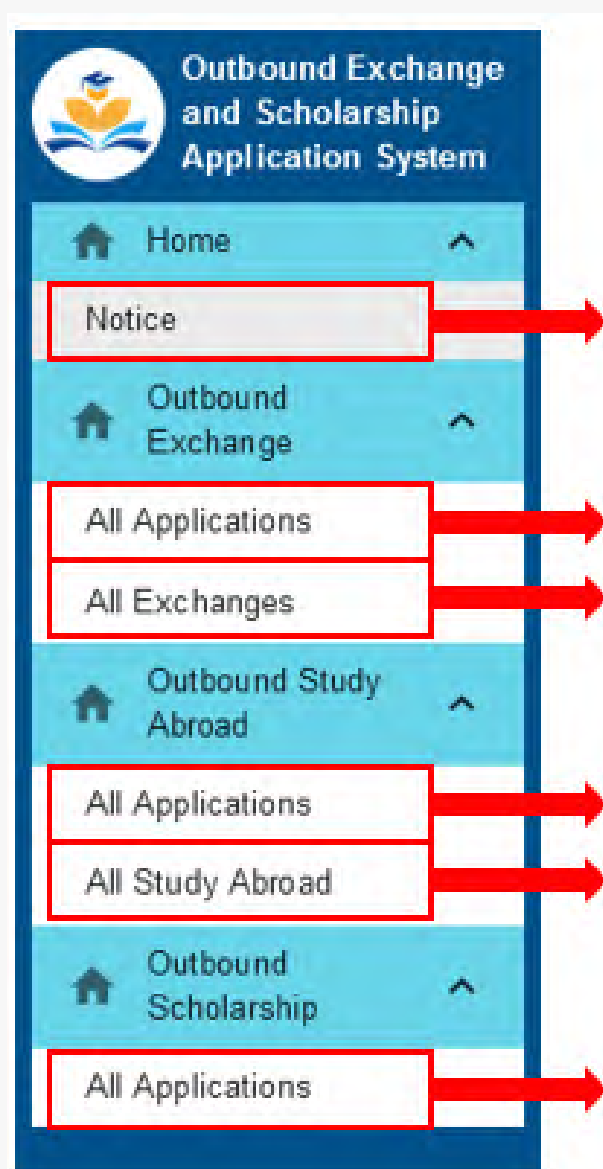

## Exchange Duration

One (1) Semester [AY2026/2027 Sem 1 (Fall 2026)] or  
One (1) Academic Year [AY2026/2027]

## Eligibility

1. Year 2 or above UG at the time of application (students who are applying for an exchange for the last semester of their current bachelor programmes are not eligible); and
2. Academic Standing with a minimum CGPA of 2.8 or above; or
3. Language proficiency required by the chosen Exchange University, if any
4. Other specific eligibility requirements by Exchange University

# Selection

Evaluation of university-level and unit-level exchange programmes are performed separately.



- GAO will arrange interviews for all eligible applicants of university-level programmes according to their first priority (i.e., first university level programme out of the six programmes).
- Interview invitations will be sent via email (the week after application is closed).
- Applicants who do not show up for the interview will not be considered.

Eligible applicants with no interview invitation should approach GAO.

## Criteria to be considered for U-level Exchange Programme

- ✗ Students who do not fulfill the application and language requirements **at the time of application** will not be considered.
- ✗ If a student fails to fulfill the requirements of his/her 1st priority university-level programme, he/she will be considered disqualified from that candidate pool.

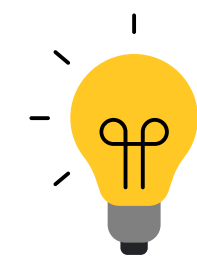
## The following will be considered in calculating the Final Grade

- Academic, awards and disciplinary: academic standing, awards, extra-curricular activities and volunteer contributions, etc.
- Interview performance
- Personality and skills

# Selection

## How applicants are ranked?

- Students who put the concerned programme as 1st priority
- Students who never joined semester exchange programmes organized by UM
- Students who meet the specific eligibilities required by the exchange university

*Applicants with any withdrawal record in their student file will be last considered.*

- ▶ If any selected nominees reject the nomination offered, backup nominees with the concerned programme as their 1st priority will be chosen according to their final grade.
- ▶ If all the backup nominees reject the exchange offer, quota(s) will be distributed to applicants who put the concerned programme as their 2nd priority, and students in this pool will be considered according to their final grade.
- ▶ If an applicant is not allocated to his/her 1st priority programme, he/she will be considered for their 2nd priority programme) based on availability **(after all applicants who have the programme as their 1st priority are allocated).**
- ▶ If an applicant is nominated for his/her 1st priority programme and the nomination offer is declined, he/ she will not be considered for other university-level programmes in the same call.

*Exchange students are selected ambassadors who represent UM in the host community.*

*Academic standing is NOT the main and only consideration in the selection.*

*Exchange Students should be ready for active participation in campus activities and engaging with the local community at host university.*





# Selection

- Application result of university-level and unit-level programmes will be announced separately via the online Portal.
- Students who receive nomination offer --> **"Accept"** or **'Decline'** the offer via the online Portal within the acceptance period.
- In case the acceptance deadline for a university-level programme is earlier than the result release date for unit-level programmes, students must decide whether to confirm the nomination offer or wait for the selection results of unit-level programmes.

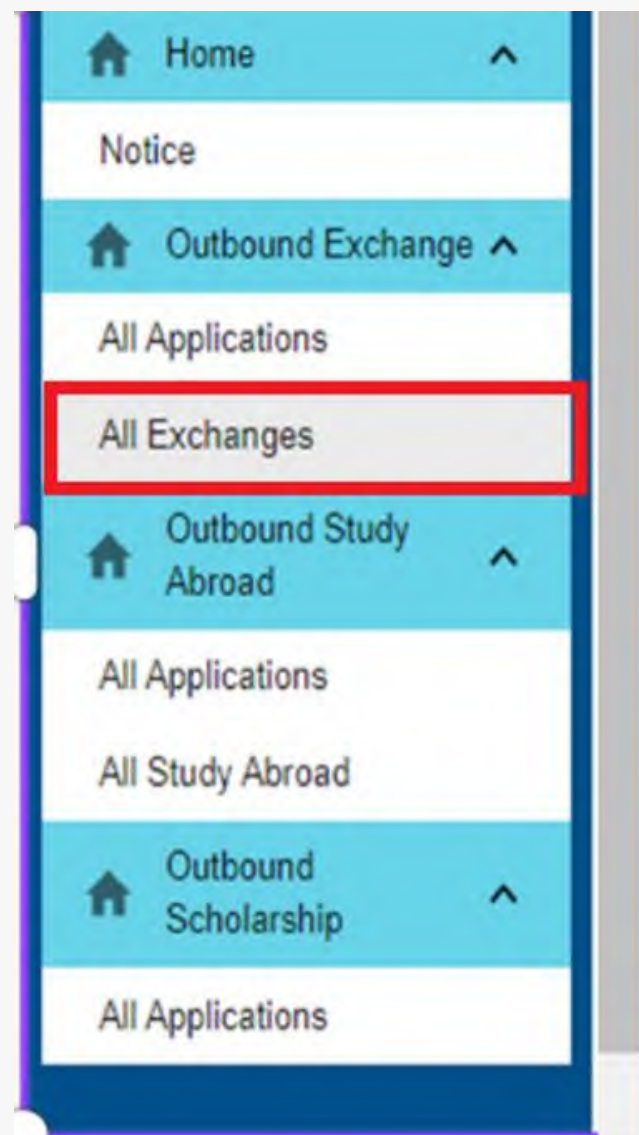

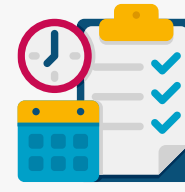

# Exchange Ambassador Scheme

The Outgoing Exchange Scholarship Scheme has been reformed as **Exchange Ambassador Scheme**.

UM invites students to become **Exchange Ambassadors** during their mobility programmes. This initiative empowers participants to enhance cultural diversity and strengthen the university's global visibility. Students will serve as UM representatives, sharing their experiences and fostering international connections.

Participants are expected to fulfill the following responsibilities:

- actively engage in the **activities organized by the host university** and showcase UM through meaningful participation;
- **promote UM as an attractive exchange destination** to peers and the host university community;
- document the abroad experience through **photos and videos**, sharing them on personal social media platforms;
- share the **insights and experience gained** during the exchange with future prospective exchange students.

Participants who fulfill the requirements will be recognized as Exchange Ambassadors and awarded a certificate. Additional monetary awards will be awarded to the distinguished ambassadors (on a limited basis).



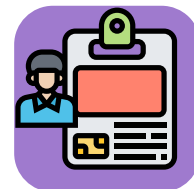

- Apply for a visa until you have received the official letter of acceptance
- Book any flights before your visa has been approved
- Miss the pre-enrollment at UM
