



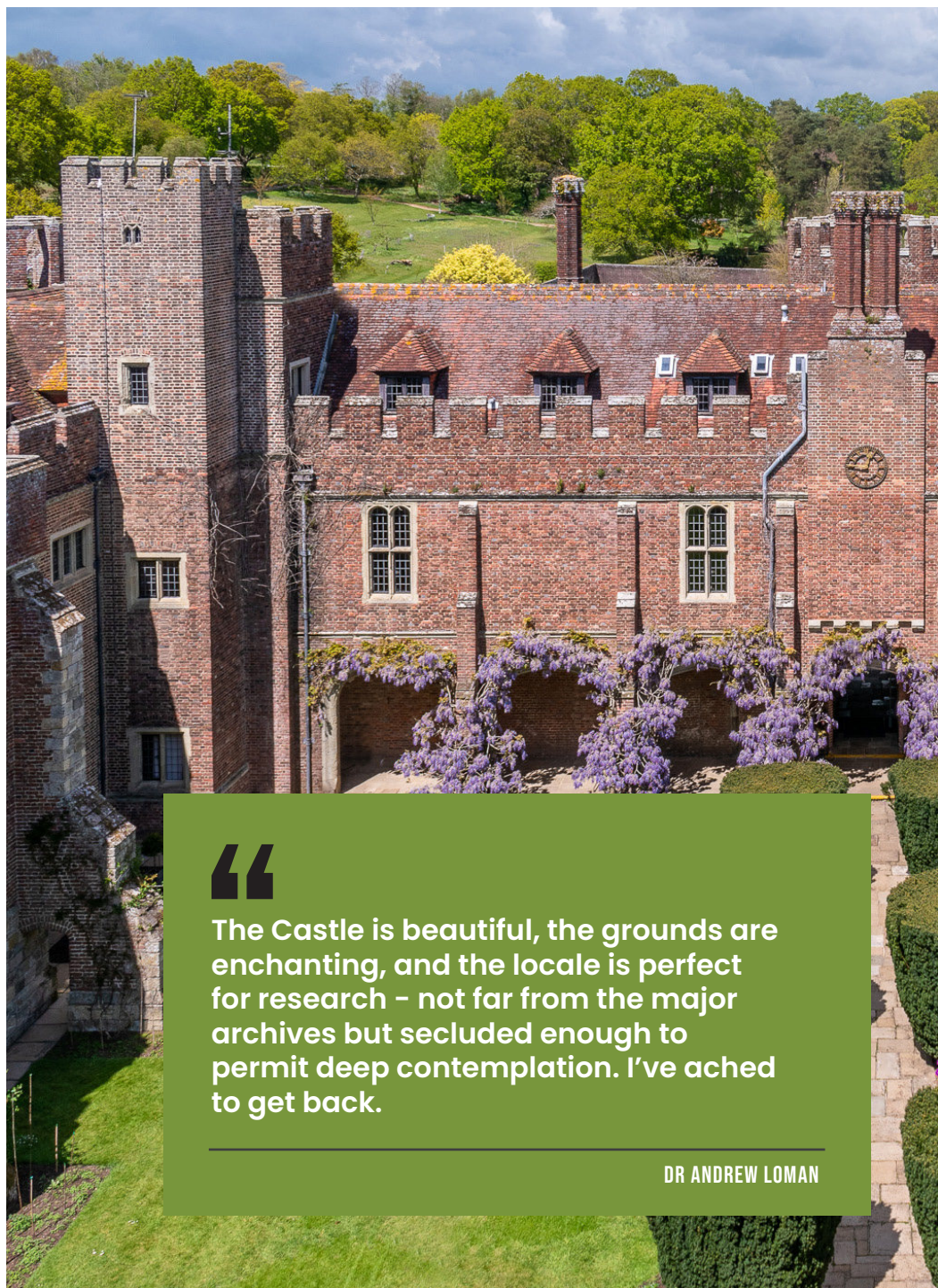

A Haven for Scholars

The Scholars Retreat at Herstmonceux Castle invites academics, postdoctoral researchers, and doctoral candidates to engage in research, writing, and reflection in a setting designed to support intellectual concentration and interdisciplinary exchange. Residencies are available from one to six months, beginning in 2026.

Bader College is the global campus of Queen's University, Canada, located at Herstmonceux Castle in the south of England. Drawing on Queen's international reputation for academic excellence, the College fosters a diverse community of scholars, students, and lifelong learners within a historic and well-resourced estate, offering a distinctive environment for innovative programming and research opportunities.

Dating back to the 15th century, the newly restored Herstmonceux Castle is located within a peaceful estate rich in biodiversity, historic architecture, formal gardens; and offering a distinctive environment conducive to sustained academic work.

The estate also houses the NERC Space Geodesy Facility, which supports satellite missions, and the Observatory Science Centre, formerly the Royal Greenwich Observatory which is home to five telescopes, and hosts regular astronomy evenings.

A Place of Peaceful Inspiration

The Castle library, located off the courtyard cloisters, is refurbished in neo-classical style, and provides a quiet retreat overlooking the south-facing formal gardens.

The estate includes a designated Site of Special Scientific Interest. Much of its ancient woodland – known to be wooded since at least the 1600s – creates a rich haven for biodiversity, supporting species established over centuries. Plans are now underway to rewild significant areas of the estate, increasing biodiversity and providing research opportunities.

Set within 600 acres of English countryside, the estate is lush with beautiful ponds, marshlands, wildflower meadows, and historic parkland. A network of trails criss-crosses the grounds, perfect for morning jogs or evening strolls.





Designed for Rest and Renewal

Scholars are accommodated in David Smith Hall or Bader Hall. Both offer private en-suite rooms or apartments designed to support rest and quietude. The residences are a short walk from the Castle itself, where each scholar has access to a dedicated office.

A comfortable desk & chair



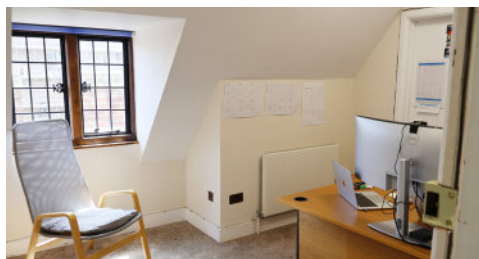

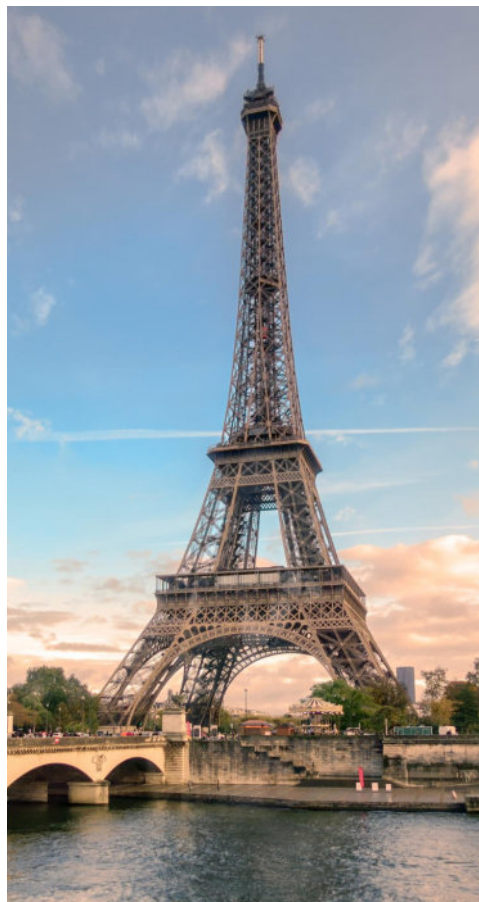
